

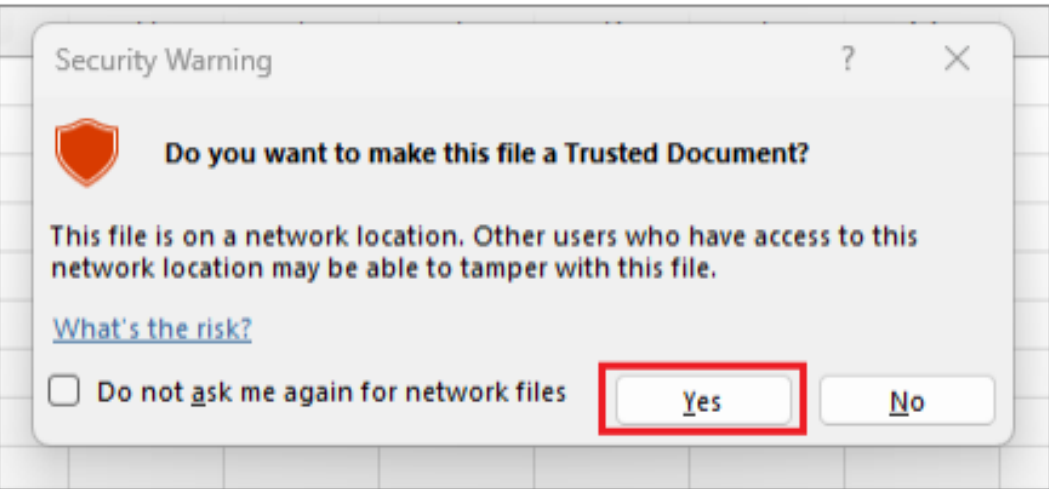
Please enable macros and make an Excel workbook a trusted document to be able to enter data and save it

When you open an Excel file you might notice a yellow or red 'Security Warning banner' under the tool bar. It is a standard Microsoft warning to protect your computer from untrusted information.

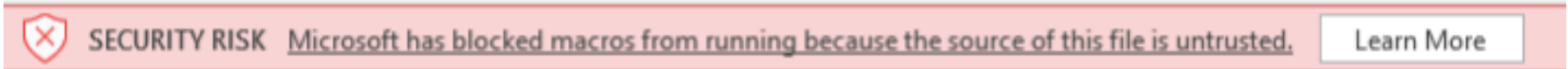
If you see a yellow "Security Warning banner"



1. Select Enable Content.
2. In the 'Security Warning' dialog, select Yes to make the document trusted.



If you see a red 'Security Warning banner'



1. Close the workbook containing the blocked macro.
2. In File Explorer go to the location where the workbook is saved.
3. Right-click the file and select Properties from the context menu.
4. In the Properties dialog box, check the Unblock box, and then click OK
